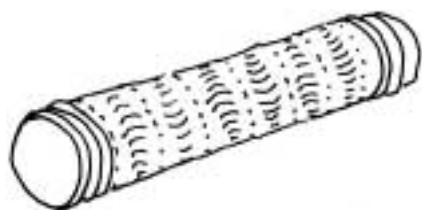


GANZA — The Ganza (*gahn-za*) is a tubular metal shaker commonly employed in Brazilian music ensembles. It is held at eye level with both hands. The sound is produced with a forward-backward shaking motion.
