

TIMBALES — The Timbales (*tim-ba-leez*), originating in Cuba, are a pair of single-headed drums mounted on a stand. They are played with thin timbale sticks in combination with hand dampening. The large timbale is placed on the player's left. The sticks are held with a matched grip.
