sub tegumento manus suae protexit me.

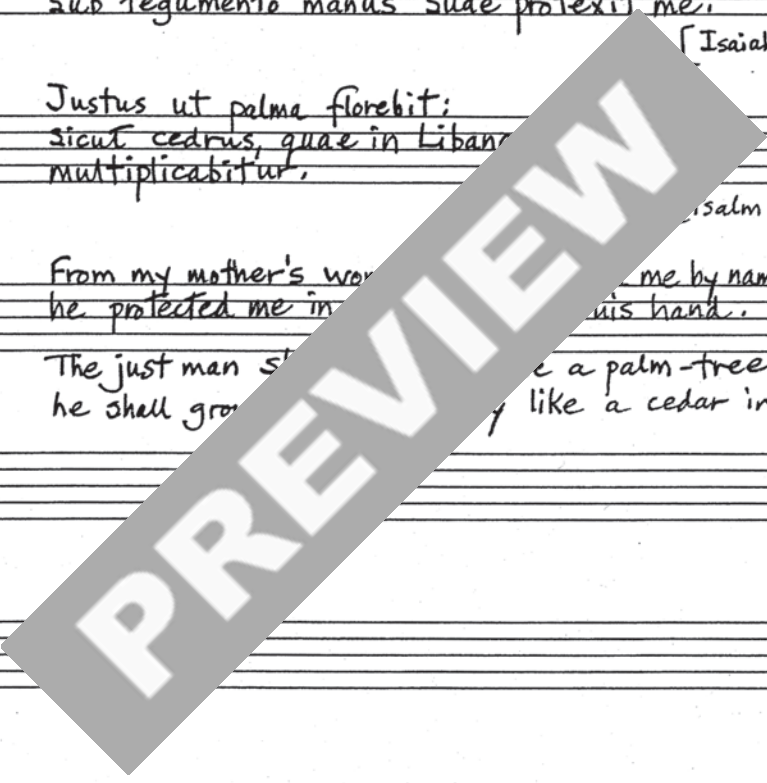
