“Hold Us, Jesus” may be used during a healing prayer service, at reconciliation services, and as an entrance processional during Lent or Advent. It also works as a prelude piece, as well as a song of praise after communion. The piece should start simply and quietly, gradually building to the end by adding layers of instruments (e.g., bass, guitar, drums, percussion). The interlude is optional but creates momentum by leading the drive to the final verse and refrain.
